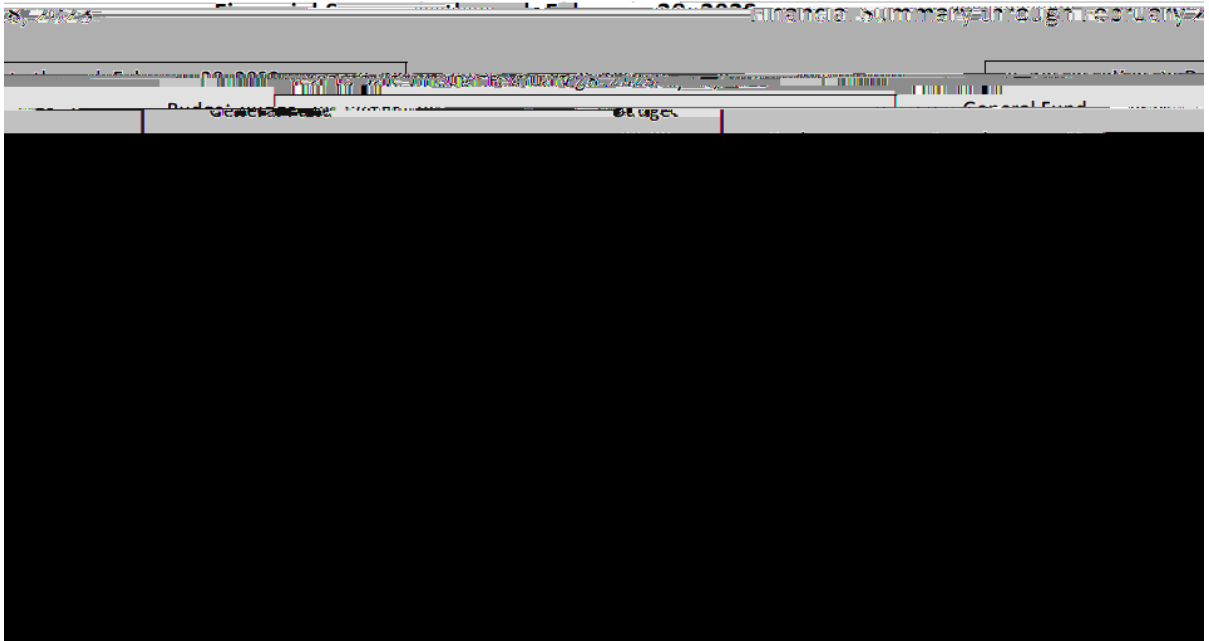
Chairperson Stenberg welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Chairperson Stenberg mentioned Graduation is May 4.


Ms. Hartman mentioned Criterion 5 was discussed at the Higher Learning Commission Conference.
