- x Full Time: Every Spring semester
- Spring Semester: Apply September 1st - October 15th

Program Acceptance:

Applications will be reviewed when ALL requirements are submitted AND prerequisite courses are completed. The program utilizes a selection process of all complete applications to determine acceptance into the program. Applications with incomplete or missi

Spring Semester (January): Please apply September/October 15.

- x First review of completed applications will begin on October 15; the application will remain open until all program seats are full.
 - x Notification of acceptance will occur on or after November 15.
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed missing requirements.
